When is this craziness?

Applications open January 1st and close February 20th

The creating will happen from 6 p.m. March 26th to 6 p.m. on March 27th

The performance will be at 7 p.m. on April 5th

Who would do this?

Anyone who thinks they can! Each team must have a designated leader, director and music director, have 5 to 15 members and be a minimum of 25% high school students and a minimum of 25% high school graduates. Oh and they need to really know how to talk smack!!

Where is this all happening?

ARTS UMBRELLA, our co-presenter, is hosting the writing in their secure premises!

The performance is at the lovely Orpheum Annex, thanks to the City of Vancouver.

Can I watch? Tickets for the worldwide premiere are \$20 and \$15 for students and seniors. Tickets will also be available to watch the Teams' writing process, which include access to the final performance. 2 hour windows are \$30/25 and a full 24 hour pass will be available for \$40/35.
