CHARACTER BREAKDOWN

Please note:

a) every role is open to all genders. Awkward Stage Productions strongly encourages artists of the LGBTQ and queer communities to audition.

b) the roles of Emory, Linda and Lady must feel comfortable with dancing and Lady must be able to sing a solo song.

Emory- An effeminate 11 year old who dreams of leaving the chicken farm and getting on *Star Search*

Elliott- A typical boy down the road. Has a parasitic twin living in his leg.

Nan- Emory’s bible thumping chicken farming grandmother who is dying of cancer

Linda- A depressed chicken who speaks with a Brooklyn accent. Emory’s best friend and confidante

Lady in a Leotard- The narrator who plays various roles such as Spider, Parasitic Twin, and Starlene. Suffers from performance anxiety and body insecurities.
